List of Items Needed:

- Knit/fleece winter hats—neutral colors
- Knit/fleece winter scarves, gloves
- Warm thick/winter socks
- Shampoo/Conditioner, Soaps
- Deodorant
- Chapstick
- Tylenol or Advil
- Toilet Paper
- Feminine Hygiene Products (small packs of tampons or sanitary napkins)
- Wipes (soft-packaged but re-closeable)
- Hand Sanitizer
- Combs/Brushes
- Nail clippers
- Fleece Blankets
- Large Plastic (garbage) bags
- Quart size Ziploc bags
- Can openers, Plastic Utensils
- Non-perishable, individually wrapped foods (cheese and crackers, granola bars, protein bars, beef jerky, etc.)

Other Useful Items:

- Bus passes
- Gift cards to stores or restaurants so they can buy food items or hot coffee.

What a great opportunity for all of us to bring a little help, hope, and Holiday Spirit to the homeless in our community!
